


Recipient Requirements:

- Valid Grazing Permit with the name of the person received livestock feed.
- Active producer with 2021 Livestock Inventory.

- Coordinate with the District Grazing Officials or Eastern Navajo Land Board Officials to complete RDCMA -07- 21 Agriculture Infrastructure Fund Livestock Feed Distribution Procurement Application.
- 3. Chapters will develop and enter AIF Budgets into the WIND System.
