SUPPORTING RESOLUTION TO RE-AFFIRM THE POLICIES OF THE COYOTE CANYON CHAPTER; THE FOLLOWING POLICIES ARE PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT, SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT FUNDS, COLLEGE STUDENT FINANCIAL/ENRICHMENT ASSISTANCE, HOUSING DISCRETIONARY FUNDS, VETERANS ORGNAIZATION, COMMUNITY LAND USE PLANNING COMMITTEE, AND FIRST EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (C.C.E.R.T)

WHERAS:

1. Pursuant to N.N.C. Title 26; Chapter 1; Section 3(A); Under the Local Governance Act, the Coyote Canyon Chapter is a certified local government entity of the Navajo Nation and codified at 11 N.N.C. Part 1, Section 10; and
2. Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 1(B)(2) of the Same "Act" Coyote Canyon Chapter is vested with the governmental authority to make decisions over local matters and to govern with responsibilities and accountability to the local citizens; and
3. The Coyote Canyon Chapter and the community understand the need to re-affirm such policies to remain compliant with the Navajo Nation policies and procedures, title 26, and tribal laws; and
4. The Coyote Canyon Chapter recognizes and acknowledges that current policies have not been re-affirm in recent times;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


