

Chavez John gave an update of his report

A special meeting was scheduled for February 14, 2023 and was cancelled, because he met with chapter officials after the chapter meeting and officials mentioned cemetery is completed and ready for implementation. Chavez questioned why the officials have not started the implementation.

Dianna Y. Nez – do a follow-up letter to the chapter officials of the meet on February 14, 2023 and ask the question again, for the files

Chavez John – requested for 2nd request from chapter officials regarding the ICIP and priority list. Chapter officials have not responded.

There was a water break on February 18, 2023 and no one from chapter contacted him, the water break was the main water line, therefore he made the decision to cancel the CLUPC meeting.

Was also present at the Grazing meeting the discussion was regarding waterline. Chavez handed out a map showing which residence will be getting water. Map shows with yellow & yellow are due for hook-up. Some residents that need the waterline will start this summer. Some families are being told they are not eligible for water line. Chavez questioned if they are coordinating with Indian Health Service and NTUA. Some are still needing the right-away, environmental clearances and homesite lease. This will impact the development within Coyote Canyon.


Now that the water line is going thru, family will start moving back.


